In honor of the newly appointed officials of the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC), national level civil society alliances and federations active in defending human rights of Nepalese people at all levels of their operations organized a felicitation ceremony in Kathmandu on November 2, 2007. Among the organizers of the event, were, Human Rights Alliance, NGO Federation of Nepal, National Federation of Disables Nepal, Dalit NGO Federation, Nepal, FECOFUN, National Federation of Irrigation Water Users, Nepal, National Federation of Drinking Water and Sanitation Users, Nepal, NEFIN, National Federation of Indigenous Women's Network.

Altogether there was the presence of around 150 people in the ceremony at Hotel Himalaya, Kupondol. Remarkable figures in the field of human rights and social justice were present on the occasion. Representatives from OHCHR, UNMIN and representatives from international organizations and diplomatic mission of Nepal were also among the guests in the program. Media personnel, lawyers, and people from different walks of profession were also present on the ceremony. From the gender perspective, there seemed to be not equal but adequate female participation.

The program started with the welcome remarks by Mr. Birendra Pokharel, President of National

Federation of Disables Nepal. Dr. Arjun Karki, President of NGO Federation of Nepal, for and on behalf of organizers, congratulate newly appointed officials of NHRC. Among the speakers were Ms. Lucky Sherpa, Mr. Bishnu Pukar Shrestha, Mr. Sushil Pyakurel, Mr. Richard Bennette, Mr. Charan Prasai, Mr. Tamrat Samuel, Mr. Sambhu Thapa, Dr. Mathura Shrestha and Mr. Pasang Sherpa. All speakers more or less expressed similar thoughts in grounds of the expected instrumental role NHRC has to play with its new leadership. They further expressed the need for identifying the common grounds for coordination between NHRC and the civil society.

Similarly, the newly appointed Honorable Chairperson Kedar Nath Upadhaya, Honorable Members Dr. Lila Pathak, Ram Nagina Singh, Dr. K.B. Rokaya and Gauri Pradhan shared their experiences and pointed out the need for a new strategy and structural as well as cultural restructuring of the commission. They extended solidarity to the civil society organizations and expressed commitment to work in coordination.

The program was chaired by the President of Human Rights Alliance Ms. Shanti Adhikari and was moderated by the General Secretary of FECOFUN, Mr. Bhola Bhattarai.

The representatives of Civil Society and Human Rights Organizations of Nepal strongly condemned and protested in front of Pakistan Embassy on November 7, against the undemocratic and autocratic move of General Pervez Musharraf. They strongly demanded the immediate withdrawal of the arbitrary move by the president of Pakistan and urge for creating and enabling environment for democratic spheres and human rights to be enjoyed by all citizens of Pakistan.

The protest program was organized in the coordination and leadership of Human Rights Alliance. The NGO Federation of Nepal, National Federation of Disabled Nepal, Dalit NGO Federation, Nepal, Federation of Community Forestry Users, Nepal (FECOFUN), National Federation of Irrigation Water Users, Nepal, National Federation of Drinking Water and Sanitation Users, Nepal, Nepal Federation of Indigenous Nationalities (NEFIN), National Federation of Indigenous Women's Network actively expressed their solidarity in the protest program. Likewise, The Physicians for Social Responsibility, Nepal, Rural Reconstruction Nepal (RRN), Informal Service Sector (INSEC), Nepal Society of Disabled (NSD), RWCF and representatives from other social organizations strongly expressed their solidarity in the program.

Ms. Shanti Adhikari, Chairperson, Dr. Sarba Raj Khadka, General Secretary and Mr. Min Bahadur Shahi, Treasurer from Human Rights Alliance actively took part in the protest program. Dr. Mathura P Shrestha, Mr. Subodh Raj Pakurel, Prof. Kapil Shrestha, Ms. Sharmila Karki, Dr. Saroj Dhital, Dr. Bharat Pradhan, Dr. Gopal Krishana Siwakoti,

Dr. Devendra Raj Pandy, Mr. Pasang Sherpa and other many human rights and social activists were actively present.

Senior human right activists such as Prof. Mathura Shrestha, Ms. Shanti Adhikari started the demonstration program by chanting slogans against the undemocratic move by General Pervez Musharraf and demanding the restoration of democracy, immediate release of detainees, protection, and respect of human rights. Prof. Kapil Shrestha read out the memorandum which was endorsed by number of Human Right Organizations of Nepal. The memorandum was distributed to all later. As any representatives from the Embassy rejected to receive the Memorandum, Dr. Arjun Karki, chairperson of NGO federation pasted the memorandum in the gate of the embassy.

## 27th World Food Day -Food Right Is Human Right-

On the occasion of 27th World Food Day, CCDST and The Right to Food Network, to which HR Alliance is also the network member, organized different events- stand up, rally, sadak natak, seminar, etc throughout the nation.

The seminar was organized in Birendra International Convention centre (BICC) on 16th October, 2007. Speaking at the seminar, representatives from civil society federations, women associations, peasant and trade union leaders urged the government to recognize freedom from poverty as fundamental rights of the people. Ms. Shanti Adhikari-Chairperson and Dr. Sarba Raj Khadka- General Secretary of Human Rights Alliance were among the Speakers at the Seminar.

## Rally and Signature Campaign for Constituent Assembly Election

A national coalition of 20 organizations including federations, alliances, networks, students, women organizations, users' groups, organizations working for *Dalit*, *Janajatis* and People with Disability organized an oppose program to the decision of seven party alliance (SPA) that suspended the CA elections and move against the spirit of the people. Organizations, working under the campaign named Campaign for Constituent Assembly, held activities to pressurize the government to immediately schedule an unchangeable date for CA Elections and to guarantee the sovereign rights of the people.

On 11th of October, the campaign organized a protest program and signature campaign in Maitighar Mandala. As many as 60,000 people put their signatures in the banner extending solidarity to the civil society initiative to pressurise the government for its early action to schedule unchangeable date for CA elections.

Similarly, on October 16, the group organized a protest rally from Hanuman Dhoka to the Maitighar Mandala. The rally later on converged into a seminar organized by Right to Food Network at BICC, Baneshwor.

## Memorandum and signature handed over to the Speaker of Parliament.

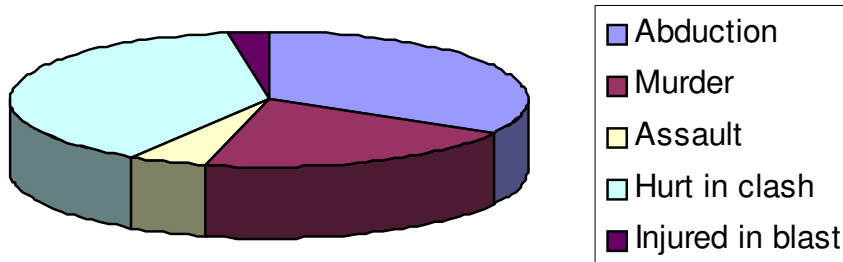
On 7 November 2007, at the secretariat of Speaker of Parliament, inside the Singh Durbar, a team of DDN (Developing Democracy in Nepal) partners met with the Speaker of Parliament Honorable Subash Nembang and handed over a citizens' memorandum demanding for immediate declaration of date for constituent assembly (CA) elections. During the meeting, the representatives of DDN seriously put their concerns over the suspension of date for CA elections and urge the government and the Seven Party Alliance (SPA) via the Speaker for early announcement of date for the elections.

One of the members of the delegation team Ms. Sharmila Karki, Secretary of NGO Federation read out the memorandum with brief highlight of demands before submitting it to the Speaker of Parliament. Mr. Rukmangat Neupane, President of Nepal Society of Disable submitted the memorandum to the Speaker. Further to this, the delegation team handed over the collected signature to pressurize the government to immediately schedule an unchangeable date for CA Elections. Accepting the signatures, the Speaker thanked the organisers and stressed the importance of CA elections. He also extended solidarity to the campaign and wished a success for its future activities.



*Demonstration Program in Maitighar Mandala to pressurize the government for immediate declaration of date for CA polls.*

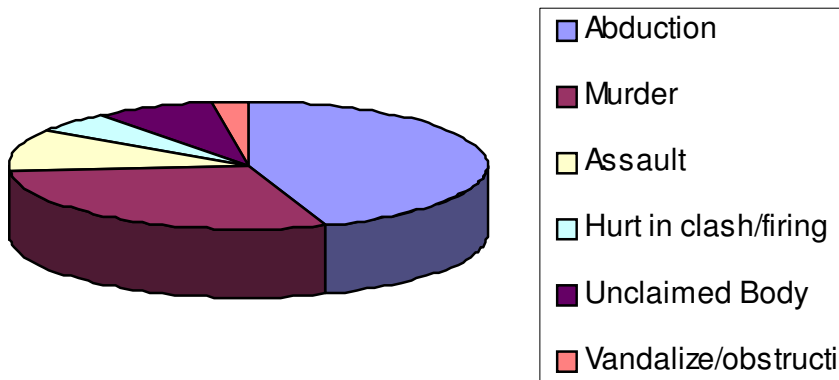
## State of Human Rights in EDR



Based on the human rights violation cases for a single month, presented on the graphs and table below, one can imagine the state of human rights in Nepal.

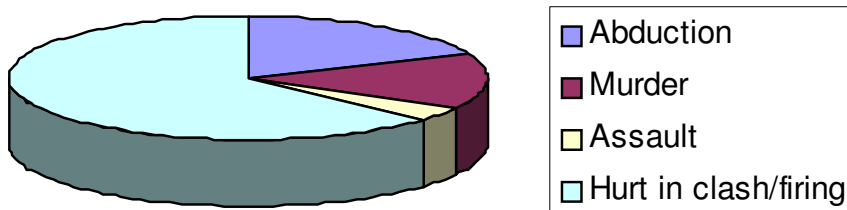
The situation is more degrading in eastern Terai and the central region. Even after the end of decade long armed conflict and the restoration of democracy, the figure indicates that Nepal is still in a very sensitive state of its peace process.

## State of Human Rights in CDR



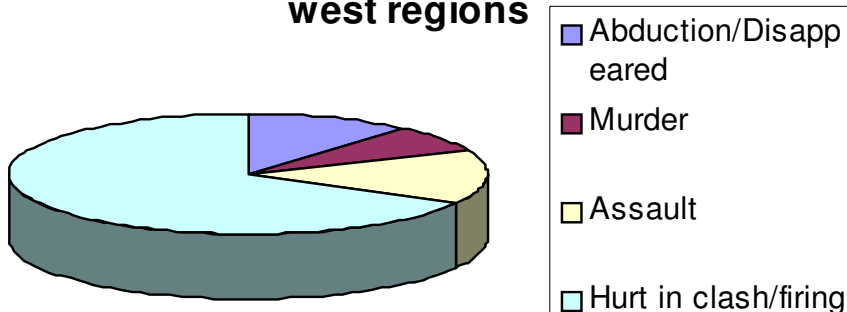
Mostly the targeted victims are found to be VDC/ officials, business person, journalists in some cases school teachers, children, youths, and so. Among the perpetrator, the involvement of unidentified groups is found to be at top, besides this JTMM- J/G/U and Maoist/YCL are among other identified groups. In few cases, police personnel are also found as perpetrators. As the Hurt in clash or injured in blast variables are taken on the basis of number injured or hurt rather than event wise, the graph seem exaggerated.
